Number of participants: Each trip has a maximum space allowance of 12 participants.

Activity and fitness level: Please note that this trip is designed for easy to moderate fitness level. Participants must be in good health, mobile and able to participate in 3-5 hours of physical activity per day, the equivalent of walking up to five miles at a 2.5-mph pace over uneven ground and varied terrain.

Deposit: Please submit a deposit of **\$500 per person** to reserve your space on any of the above trips.

Full payment of trip fee is due by April 13 2009 (Wyoming), June 30, 2009 (Washington/Cascades) or August 17, 2009 (Maine).

Cancellations and refunds: All Deposits are fully refundable up until 90 days from the set trip date. The Wilderness Society reserves the right to cancel any trip due to inadequate sign-up or other cause that makes the trip unfeasible for us to operate, and will inform you as soon as possible. In such a case, a full refund is given but The Wilderness Society is not responsible for additional expenses incurred by members preparing for the trip (airline tickets, supplies, etc).
